



How to Play Texas Hold'Em Poker

This five card game is one of the most popular poker games worldwide.

The Basics

In Texas Hold'Em, it's you against the other players at the table. The object of the game is to put together your best poker hand using the cards you are dealt and the Dealer's "community" cards.

Minimum and maximum buy-ins and re-buys apply to each game limit.

Maximum and minimum bets are posted at the poker tables.

The table seats a maximum of 10 players.

Two cards will be dealt to each player followed by the first of 4 rounds of betting. The Dealer will then turn over 3 community cards, (which are used by all players at the table) and the 2nd round of betting commences. The 4th community card is turned over followed by the 3rd betting round. When the 5th and final community card is exposed, the final round of betting begins. Players may use any combination to form their highest 5-card poker hand. The Dealer will award the pot to the player with the highest hand. Casino Rama shall derive its revenue at all poker tables by extracting a commission known as a rake or a session fee.

House Rules

House Rules are posted in the poker room. All players are expected to follow these rules.

Bad Beat

Bad Beat is a term for a hand in which a player with what appears to be strong cards nevertheless loses. A Bad Beat Jackpot is a prize that is paid when a sufficiently strong hand loses to an even stronger hand held by another player.

There must be at least 4 players who are "active" in the hand (present for the initial deal); The pot must be a minimum of \$20; A player must lose with a hand of **Four of a Kind or Better**. **Both** hole cards in **both** the highest and second highest hands must be used to make the best five-card hand.

Other

You are welcome to tip the Dealers at your discretion; we believe tipping is an opportunity for customers to reward good service and professional dealing skills.
